REGISTRATION PLATFORM:

REGISTRATION PROCESS:

- **Preparing Your Entries:** (Optional) Before starting your entries, download a blank PDF for each category you wish to participate in. This will help you fully prepare, prior to starting your entry process.
- **File Formats for Upload:** For images, please upload JPEG, JPG, or PNG files. For videos, you may upload mp4 or mov files. The maximum file size is 20MB per photo and 100MB per video.
- **Expanded Image Allowance:** We're pleased to announce that you can now submit more images! Attach up to eight files with your entry, following this breakdown:
 - **IMPORTANT! Image 1:** This should always be **your BEST image**, even when submitting a video. Quality images are required by NADRA HQ for your award and presentation purposes. **DO NOT UPLOAD A VIDEO AS YOUR FIRST IMAGE!**
 - **Image 2:** Share a "Before" photo of your project.
 - **Images 3 - 7:** You are welcome to share any project images you'd like.
 - Please ensure each image is within the 20MB limit.
 - **Video** (optional): If you choose to include a video, it must be 60 seconds or less and not exceed 100MB. While a video is not required, we highly recommend it. Alternatively, you can upload a **8th image** if you prefer.

REGISTRATION PROCESS CONTINUED:

A Quick Reminder: Please **No Branding** on your images and **Do Not** include your company name or personal name in the file name or project name. Adhering to these guidelines ensures a fair evaluation of all entries. We appreciate your commitment to excellence in every aspect of the competition.

Mandatory questions you must answer in the registration process:

- Your Direct Contact Number: Please provide a direct number where NADRA HQ can reach you for any questions related to your entry. *Kindly note that this number should not be your 800 number or office line.*

- NADRA Member Address: Please enter your address (**not the customer's address**).
- Project Description: Utilize this space to furnish essential details about your project. Describe any relevant aspects of the build, including challenges you overcame and instances of exceptional craftsmanship that may not be apparent in the photos alone. This section is pivotal for judges, helping them understand what might not be immediately visible in an image. Take this section seriously to provide an insightful perspective. Using bullets makes it easier for judges to read. (**DO NOT USE YOUR NAME IN THIS SECTION!**)
- Materials Used: Provide information about the materials employed in this project.
- Industry Partner Inclusion: Would you like to extend the invitation to your industry partners to participate alongside you in this project? Refer to page 15 of the handbook for a definition of "Industry Partner."
- If Yes to Industry Partner Inclusion: Please furnish the Industry Partner's Contact Information.

Ensuring you complete these mandatory sections aids in the comprehensive evaluation of your entry. Your meticulous input plays a vital role in providing the judges with the necessary context to assess your project effectively. We appreciate your dedication to ensuring a thorough and transparent competition process.

RULES:

Entry Eligibility:

- Entries will exclusively be accepted from current NADRA members in good standing.
- **All current Deck Builders must have on file current proof of general liability insurance and license as/if required in your state.**
- All projects must have been completed by a NADRA Deck Builder/Contractor member.
- Submitted projects should demonstrate completion in either the years 2024 or 2025.
- Projects that were previously entered in any prior NADRA National+ Deck Competition **are ineligible for submission.**
- There is no cap on the number of entries permitted.

Project Types and Exceptions:

- All entries submitted must be residential projects, except for the Product Display category and the Commercial Deck Project category.
- **IMPORTANT:** To be considered for the "Overall Best Deck Project," you must be entered into one of the following categories: Wood Deck (3 price ranges) or Alternative Deck (5 price ranges) **NOTE:** does not include Refurbished category.
- Category details, including any entry specifications, are provided on pages 10 - 13. Kindly refer to these pages for a list of categories and their respective parameters.

Price Guidelines and Minimum Entries:

- By entering a specific category, you confirm that your project complies with the designated price guidelines for that category (e.g., Wood Deck Under \$25k). Categories must be entered based on the full project contract price — not just the decking. If it is part of the contract and shown in the photos, it must be included when determining the correct price-point category (e.g., pergolas, waterfalls, lighting, railings, under-decking, unique structures, etc.).
- **NEW for 2025:** A signed customer contract must be uploaded with each project entry. The contract must clearly show the total project price paid and include the customer's signature.
- Important: Each category requires a minimum of three member project entries to qualify. If this minimum is not met, entry fees will be refunded and you will have the opportunity to participate in the following year, when applicable.

RULES CONTINUED:

Disclosure for Deck Builders, Sponsored, or Affiliated Members:

- If you are a Deck Builder and are sponsored by, or serve as an Ambassador for manufacturers in lighting, decking, railing, fasteners, etc., and have received discounted or gifted products, it is imperative to account for the resale value of such products when selecting your category's price point. Should further clarification be necessary, we encourage you to engage with NADRA HQ for assistance.

Verification of Category Price Range:

- **IMPORTANT:** *NADRA HQ and/or Judges retain the right, at any stage during the entry and scoring process, to verify that a project has been entered into the correct price-point category.*
- All entries must include a signed customer contract showing the total project price.
- NADRA HQ and/or Judges may also request a copy of the permit (if applicable) to further validate the entry.
- Entrants are expected to supply any requested documentation within three (3) business days. Failure to comply may result in disqualification of the project(s).
- Reminder: Deck categories must be entered based on the full project contract price. If it is part of the contract and shown in the photos, it must be included when determining the appropriate price-point category.
- This process ensures fairness, transparency, and consistency across all entries, protecting every member who participates in the competition.

Project Partners:

- For Project Partners who choose to enter a project alongside a builder, current NADRA membership is a prerequisite. Please refer to page 15 for additional Project Partner details.

Media Rights and Usage:

- Entrants must hold the rights to all photos and videos uploaded for competition purposes.
- NADRA retains the right to utilize all submitted photos and videos for future promotional materials, websites, social media, videos, marketing endeavors, and correlated content.

2025 NATIONAL+ DECK COMPETITION CATEGORIES & RULES:

1. Alternative Deck Under \$35k Residential Project: Includes aluminum, cap-stock, composite, plastic, PVC, stone, vinyl, etc

2. Alternative Deck \$36k - \$70k Residential Projects: Includes aluminum, cap-stock, composite, plastic, PVC, stone, vinyl, etc

3. Alternative Deck \$71k - \$150k Residential Project: Includes aluminum, cap-stock, composite, plastic, PVC, stone, vinyl, etc

4. Alternative Deck \$151k - \$250k Residential Project: Includes aluminum, cap-stock, composite, plastic, PVC, stone, vinyl, etc

5. Alternative Deck \$251k - \$500k Residential Project: Includes aluminum, cap-stock, composite, plastic, PVC, stone, vinyl, etc (Project price point is NEW)

NEW

6. Alternative Deck Over \$500k Residential Project: Includes: aluminum, cap-stock, composite, plastic, PVC, stone, vinyl, etc (Project price point is NEW)

7. Wood Deck Under \$25k Residential Project: Includes Pressure Treated, Cedar, Redwood, Southern Pine, Ipe, Hardwoods, etc.

8. Wood Deck \$26k - \$50k Residential Project: Includes Pressure Treated, Cedar, Redwood, Southern Pine, Ipe, Hardwoods, etc.

9. Wood Deck Over \$50k Residential Project: Includes Pressure Treated, Cedar, Redwood, Southern Pine, Ipe, Hardwoods, etc.

10. Commercial Outdoor Living Project: To include a deck: Must be a commercial address such as a restaurant, boardwalk, Doctor's Office, etc. * For builders only, not a category for Manufacturers.

11. Dock Residential Project: A structure extending alongshore or out from the shore into a body of water. Projects must be residential. If you have a beautiful commercial dock category, please enter it in the Commercial Outdoor Living Category.

NEW

12. Framing: Open to residential deck projects that incorporate **framing alternative systems** using materials beyond traditional pressure-treated lumber, such as steel, aluminum, or composites. Projects may include full or partial alternative framing, as long as the use of nontraditional materials is a key structural element. ***This category is not to be confused with Alternative Deck Price points. NOTE: submission portal will allow for 4 price points for “Framing”: UP TO 70K, 71k to 150k, 151k to 250k, 251k AND UP***

13. Hardscape Residential Project: (No size limit) Includes any flat surface project that includes pavers, turf, natural stone, concrete, or stone finish. At this time, Hardscape category projects may not be entered into any other category, including the Unique Feature category.

14. Illumination Residential Project: Show the use of outdoor illumination of outdoor living spaces, decks, private gardens and public landscapes; for the enhancement and purposes of safety, nighttime aesthetics, accessibility, security, recreation and more.

15. Inlay on a Deck Residential Project: Inlay is the visual arts/decorative technique used to create an ornamental design, pattern, or scene by inserting a different material or different color or type on a deck.

NEW

16. Limitless Creation up to \$200k (Residential Project): Outdoor living project that includes a deck. Open to all materials, including pools. If you have a spectacular project that has outstanding qualities that includes multiple categories, consider entering it into this category. (Project price point is NEW)

17. Limitless Creation up to \$201k - \$400k (Residential Project): Outdoor living project that includes a deck. Open to all materials, including pools. If you have a spectacular project that has outstanding qualities that includes multiple categories, consider entering it into this category. (Project price point is NEW)

18. Limitless Creation Over 400k (Residential Project): Outdoor living project that includes a deck. Open to all materials, including pools. If you have a spectacular project that has outstanding qualities that includes multiple categories, consider entering it into this category. (Project price point is NEW)

categories:

2025 NATIONAL+ DECK COMPETITION CATEGORIES & RULES:

19.Pool Deck Residential Project: includes the surface areas surrounding the pool. Materials include all decking types, including hardscapes. The project must include a pool. The pool does not need to be built by the member. The space around the pool is what is being judged, not the pool.

20.Product Display - Deck Builder/Contractor Members Only: (No size limit) includes Show Rooms, Home Show Booths, Exhibit Displays, and even Mobile Rig Displays. This category is intended for all business types: contractors, manufacturers, lumberyards, dealers, and retail stores.

21.Porch - Closed Residential Project: An enclosed room attached to the outside of a house/building.

22.Porch - Open Residential Project: An open room attached to the outside of a house/building.

23.Railing on a Deck Residential Project: Whether it's real wood, cable, aluminum, glass, WPC, Steel, Metal, or Wrought Iron. This category is to showcase the functionality and beauty of a railing on a deck.

2025 NATIONAL+ DECK COMPETITION CATEGORIES & RULES:

24. Refurbished / Refinished Deck Residential Project: Most of the existing framing and the basic layout must be retained. Staining of existing boards or new decking, Before photo must be included as one of the photos uploaded. Refurbished Decks may not be submitted into any of the other deck categories such as Wood Deck, Alternative Deck or Limitless Creation. If you upgraded a refurbished space to include beautiful lighting or unique features, you may enter it into the Illumination or Unique Feature categories. Please contact NADRA if you need clarification.

25. Unique Feature Residential Project: (but not limited to) fire pit, fireplace, pergola, pavilion, free-standing structure, creative/challenging lighting, underdecking, curves, creative inlays, outdoor kitchen/bar, water feature, outdoor shower, etc. Please do not upload any Commercial or Hardscape projects into this category.



Note: The Product Display for Vendors – Category Removed for 2025

This category, previously open to vendor members for showrooms, home show booths, exhibit displays, and mobile rigs, has been discontinued. Vendors are encouraged to collaborate with NADRA builder members to enter their exhibits under the Product Display category available to Builder/Contractor members. After a deck builder enters, you have the option to “Partner” with them.

judging:

JUDGING CRITERIA:

- The 8 Photos that you submit (**First photo MUST be your best photo!**)
- The video will be used to show the scope of the project. The video will not receive a score.
- Use of Space / Functionality
- Creativity / Innovation
- Evidence of Craftsmanship
- Degree of Difficulty
- Overall Visual Appeal
- Description Provided by Entrant
- *****Judging for certain categories may vary.** Example: The Illumination category may include judging criteria more relevant to outdoor lighting standards & techniques.

SCORING:

- NADRA uses **decimal scoring** to provide a finer level of assessment. This approach ensures that every detail and aspect of your project is recognized with greater accuracy, allowing us to celebrate your work on a precise scale.
- Once the competition closes, NADRA Headquarters grants access to the judges. **Judges remain anonymous until winners are announced.**
- All scores are processed through NADRA's secure internal real-time leaderboard, which compiles results as judges enter their scores.

RESULTS:

- Our focus will be on celebrating the outstanding achievements of a First, Second and Third place winner for each category.
- Round Two & Overall First Place - All first-place winners from each decking category (Wood Deck – all price points, and Alternative Deck – all price points) advance to a final round of judging. These projects are scored a second time. The project with the highest score from this round will be named the Overall First Place Winner.
- **Please note:** The Overall First Place Winner will be awarded to a project entered in either the Wood Deck or Alternative Deck categories only. If you would like your project to be considered **for this distinction, be sure to enter it in one of these respective categories.**
- Results are not shared prior to the awards dinner outside of NADRA Headquarters or beyond the President of NADRA. Winners will not be notified prior to the awards presentation.
- The exception to industry media publications applies. Some winner details may be shared at the discretion of NADRA Headquarters in order to meet various deadlines with leading industry digital and print publications.

project partners:

The Partner option holds a dual purpose: not only does it facilitate the expansion of NADRA membership, but it also fosters a sense of camaraderie and mutual support across all facets of the industry. Please extend an invitation to your industry collaborators and peers, urging them to participate in the competition alongside you!

PROJECT PARTNERS DEFINED:

- A partner, within this context, denotes a NADRA member who played a pivotal role in a project submitted to the National+ Deck Competition. **Partners cover a diverse array of roles, ranging from architects and decking materials experts to designers, distributors, fastener/hardware specialists, framers, hardscape material providers, inspectors, lighting professionals, lumberyards/retail stores, railing experts, staining specialists, tool/toolbelt suppliers, under-decking experts, creators of unique features (e.g., fire, water, pergola, sun shades), and more.**
- **Vital Note:** It's important to clarify that partners are distinctly different from sponsors. Being a Partner does not mean you are also a Sponsor. Partnering with a Deck Builder reflects an active role in a specific project and thus the “Partner” becomes an “Entrant”, while sponsorships involves registering to support the Awards Summit as a sponsor.

HERE'S HOW THE PARTNER OPTION OPERATES:

1. Builders submit their entries to NADRA's National+ Deck Competition through the online portal.
2. Builders list on each entry who they wish to partner with. We highly recommend that the deck builder contacts potential partners. (If you are a manufacturer or another potential partner, encourage your builders to inform you if they're participating and to list you as a potential partner.)
3. As a listed partner, NADRA then contacts all potential partners and invites partners to register. NADRA provides to partners a list and it is their decision whether to participate.
4. Should a Partner win, Partners receive recognition and an award.
5. All winning partners receive coverage in NADRA news, blogs, website, and across our social media channels, along with various industry print and digital publications.
6. Partner submissions are priced at \$150 per project, per partner.
7. Partner registration takes place on a dedicated portal, separate from the deck competition. NADRA members will receive notifications about the opening of partner registration.

hints & tips:

A WORD FROM NADRA HEADQUARTERS & PAST JUDGES:

- *Read the handbook first – Every page matters. Knowing the guidelines helps avoid simple mistakes.*
- *Show the deck clearly – Tidy the space, remove distractions, and let the design shine.*
- *Highlight craftsmanship – Include close-ups of details and features that reflect quality and care.*
- *Tell the story – Your write-up is your chance to go beyond the photos. Share challenges you overcame, special features, and what makes the deck unique. Take time to describe what photos cannot show.*
- *Use variety – Wide shots, detail shots, before/after comparisons, and overhead perspectives help show the full scope.*
- *Make photos count – Clear, well-lit images (professional or carefully planned) ensure your work is presented fairly.*
- *Leverage video (up to 1 minute) – A short walk-through or drone clip can capture angles and details still photos can't. Just make sure you and any company branding stay out of the frame.*
- *Include a “before” photo – A well-chosen before shot helps highlight transformation and dramatic change.*
- *Use lighting wisely – Aim for even light (full sun or shade) to avoid harsh contrast that hides important details.*
- *Show what sets it apart – Creativity and originality are what judges remember. Make sure your entry communicates the “wow” factor.*

Category descriptions are outlined in the Official Handbook. By entering the competition, you agree to have read the Official Handbook, which is updated every year. You must read the handbook before submitting your first entry.
